

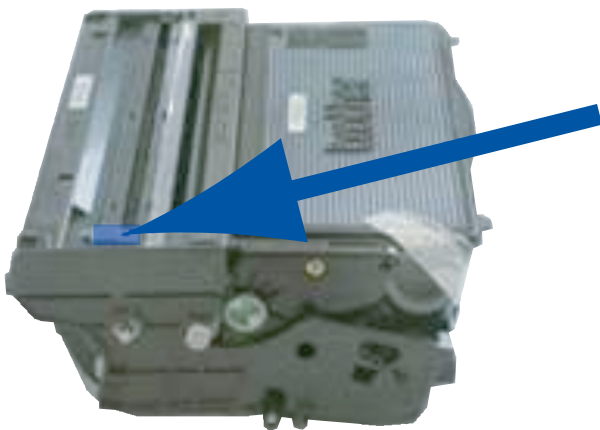
TRANSFER CORONA WIRE CLEANING METHODS

The transfer corona is a thin wire strung lengthwise through the corona casing area. This wire must be clean to ensure that the image written on the electro-photographic drum properly transfers to the paper. Refer to the User's Manual for help in determining the location of the transfer corona wire and surrounding areas.

Brother's TCW system varies slightly, most TCW are part of the actual drum unit and are recognisable by the blue or green tab on the top of the unit

IMPORTANT:

'To ensure optimum print quality, please move the blue tab on your printers drum unit back and forth several times after changing your toner cartridge'



Note: If the slider encounters resistance as it is moved, stop and return it to your store for expert cleaning.
